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Lifestyle feature of new 'village'

A new multimillion-dollar development approved by Logan City Council last week is expected to further enhance one of the city's five commercial hubs.

The Comiskey Corporation development, 'Meadowbrook Lakes' on land next to the Griffith University campus at Meadowbrook, will combine commercial and mixed business with residential and student accommodation.

Development, Health and Environment Committee Chairman Councillor Darren Power and Division 6 Councillor Pam Parker said they were pleased with the project.

Cr Parker said she was encouraged to see that the Comiskey Corporation had a desire to bring such high quality development to Logan.

She said the development, which would house more than 1200 people, would boost Meadowbrook's reputation as a technology hub, which was already home to the Logan Hospital, Griffith University and Logan TAFE.

Comiskey Corporation's Stephen Comiskey said the development would be a fully master planned community with an emphasis on health and recreation.

"The negative perceptions of Logan are changing and we believe the development will prove to be a success because of its uniqueness," he said.

"Meadowbrook Lakes is a development with lifestyle, it has good transport links, it borders onto the golf course and the university is the jewel of the crown."

"Meadowbrook Lakes" is the Comiskey Corporation's second major development following its "Wimbledon Park Estate" at Morayfield.
